ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS TERMINATING THE STATE OF DISASTER WITHIN THE TOWN RELATED TO THE DANGERS TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE FROM THE WEST NILE VIRUS AND THE PROLIFERATION OF MOSQUITOES THAT CARRY THE SAME; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE GIVEN PROMPT AND GENERAL PUBLICITY AND BE FILED PROMPTLY WITH THE CITY SECRETARY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2012 the Mayor of the Town of Addison, Texas ("City"), pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code ("Code"), issued an order declaring a state of disaster for the Town in connection with the West Nile Virus and the dangers to the public health, safety and welfare resulting therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the local declaration of disaster was continued in effect by the City Council's adoption of Ordinance No. _____, which Ordinance provides that the disaster declaration would continue in effect until terminated by order of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the proclamation of a local state of disaster have ceased to exist and, accordingly, the City Council desires to end the local declaration of disaster.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

Section 1. Termination of Local State of Disaster. The City Council of the Town of Addison, Texas, as the governing body of the City, hereby terminates the local state of disaster described in and continued by Ordinance No. _____ of the City. Accordingly, the provisions of Ordinance No. _____ shall have no further force or effect.

Section 2. Publicity. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this termination of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Section 3. Incorporation of Recitals. The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
