

**RESOLUTION NO. R20-\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS EXTENDING THE AMENDED ORDER SIGNED BY ADDISON MAYOR JOE CHOW ON MARCH 16, 2020 IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2020, Mayor Joe Chow, Mayor of the Town of Addison, Texas issued an Order prohibiting public or private “Community Gatherings” to help prevent and control COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2020, Mayor Joe Chow, Mayor of the Town of Addison, Texas issued an Amended Order to further help prevent and control COVID-19, and

**WHEREAS**, on March 18, 2020, Mayor Joe Chow, Mayor of the Town of Addison, Texas issued an Amended Order to further help prevent and control COVID-19, and

**WHEREAS**, on March 19, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas issued an Executive Order temporarily closing all Texas schools, prohibiting dining-in at bars and restaurants, and limiting social gatherings to 10 people in an effort to combat the novel coronavirus’ spread, and

**WHEREAS**, extending the Amended Order Signed by Addison Mayor Joe Chow is in the best interest of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2.** The Amended Order, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on Monday, March 18, 2020, shall be renewed and continued through Tuesday, April 14, 2020 the Town’s next regularly scheduled meeting date, in accordance with section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.
