The City Council of the Town of Addison, Texas hereby approves a policy to adopt utility rates to fully fund the short-term staffing plan with a mix of cash and bond funding, utilizing cost of service adjustment as set forth in the Raftelis Financial Plan and Rate Model, with said rates to become effective on October 1, 2018.
