





SIGN CODE COMPLIANCE ISSUES

- The proposed wall sign exceeds the maximum letter/logo height and maximum total area permitted by the Sign Code.
- <u>Applicant Justification</u>:
 - The suite is near the back of the site, over 200 feet from Inwood Road. The larger sign would allow for greater visibility from the right-of-way.



MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION CRITERIA:

The council may consider appeals on the <u>basis that such regulations and/or</u> <u>standards will, by reason of exceptional circumstances or surroundings,</u> <u>constitute a practical difficulty or unnecessary hardship</u> or on the basis that the proposed improvement although falling under the definition of a "sign," constitutes art that makes a positive contribution to the visual environment.

Proposal does meet hardship criteria

• Due to the need to utilize the term, "Animal Hospital" in the signage, strict application of the sign code would result in a poorly scaled sign that has reduced visibility from Inwood Road.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends **approval of the request.**

The proposed sign is appropriately scaled for the building and is compatible with other signs along the Inwood corridor.

The attached sign will comply with all other applicable standards within the sign code and meets the "hardship" criteria of the sign code.
