



SIGN CODE COMPLIANCE REVIEW

- The proposed wall sign exceeds the maximum letter/logo height permitted by the Sign Code.
- Applicant Justification:
 - The ongoing Midway Road
 Revitalization Project has created hardship for the business.
 - Increased sign height will provide additional visibility from Midway Road.

MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION CRITERIA:

• The council may consider appeals on the basis that <u>such regulations and/or standards</u> will, by reason of exceptional circumstances or surroundings, constitute a practical <u>difficulty or unnecessary hardship</u> or on the basis that the proposed improvement although falling under the definition of a "sign," constitutes art that makes a positive contribution to the visual environment.

Proposal <u>does</u> meet hardship criteria:

- The Midway Road Revitalization Project is <u>not</u> an unnecessary hardship.
- This site's proximity to Farmers Branch, where much larger signs are permitted, is a hardship, as the existing sign at the western façade is out of character with the eastern frontage of the Midway corridor.
- The proposed sign is appropriately scaled for the building.



RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the request.
